

- The school closing hearing was advertised in accordance with the law.
- The recommendation from the Superintendent and feedback at the hearing reflect the fact that the closing of two schools is not a viable option.
- Superintendent's recommendation was to focus in on the possible closing of only one school, Audubon Elementary.
- Moving forward, the focus should continue to be on the possible closing of Audubon Elementary and the gathering of information with help from a committee structure to address the community concerns.
