IMPLEMENTATION PROCESS FOR WONDERS

- Structured in a way that will allow for a new system & building new teams
- Initial PD will occur prior to the end of the school year
- Teachers will have materials for summer planning
- Summer curriculum writing is scheduled (will reflect skills-based instruction)
- Recommending a TOA for ELA and grade level liaisons to assist throughout initial year of implementation
- Additional PD to follow in 2017-2018
- Parent sessions will be planned for 2017-2018

IMPLEMENTATION PROCESS FOR GLENCOE

- PD prior to end of school year:
 - High School Algebra I teachers > Intro to Connect Ed (1/2 day)
 - All Algebra I teachers > In-depth look at supplemental resources attached to Connect Ed (1/2 day)
- Teachers will have materials for summer planning
- Time at start of 2017-2018 school year for collaboration
- Schedule in-service time for follow-up work
