5. Co-Vice Presidents' Reports: Gabby Winters and Heather Gulsby-Steiner

Heather Gulsby-Steiner reported:

She asked about where to send bus driver appreciation fund money. She also brought up the movie license and the possibility of having movie night fundraisers from time to time.

8. Principal's Report: Zanthia Reddish

Dr. Reddish reported:

We have kindergarten registration and screening on March 10 and 11. Families can call in for their appointment times next week. We use the screening data for Jump Start and to balance classes.

The Pennsylvania Department Of Education has extended the PSSA window by 1 week. So, for the district, elementary K-4 will be pushed back to 3/24 - 3/28. We are looking to do one test a day with exception of that Thursday we'll have 2 tests.

We had an assembly scheduled for March 28. The company will resc hedule to June 5. Fun Day will now be June 12, rain date June 13. She will follow up with Gene. She was looking to see what else we could do – we could do a movie day for 3rd and 4th grade – just as a treat.

The Science Fair is tonight, and will take place weather permitting. If weather interferes, it will be moved to February 18.

Report cards came home with a letter explaining that conferences are now on a regular school day, and parents will need to coordinate a time with their teacher.

Regarding staffing changes, some staff members are pregnant. Megan Johnson will be out and Rick Joers will be in for her. Mrs. Mackay will be going out on pregnancy leave as well, but further out in the school year.

They are trying to clear the blacktop of the snow so the kids can get back outside for recess. Valentine's Day parties this year are for kindergarten only, but if we don't have school tomorrow, parties won't be rescheduled. Kids can exchange Valentines on Tuesday when they come back – probably during indoor recess.
