

Welcoming the Class of 2020 Home to the MHS Campus

Plan for Members of the Class of 2020 and Families to Visit MHS Campus in July 2020

An opportunity will be provided for members of the Class of 2020 and their families to visit the Methacton High School campus on designated days in July. Graduates and families will be able to visit identified areas of campus and take pictures in caps and gowns. An electronic SignUpGenius registration link is included below for all families to arrange for an hour-long visit. Information about the visits is outlined below.

- **Dates:** July 1, July 7, July 13
- **Hours:** 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM; hour-long visits; 15 graduates and families per hour
- **Registration:** All graduates and families are required to register via the following link - <https://tinyurl.com/y8r67mxq> in advance of the visit. It is respectfully requested that all graduates and families limit their registration to one visit per graduate/family. Visits are scheduled in one-hour increments. Out of respect for the need to maintain social distance guidelines and to allow for all families to have an opportunity to participate, please adhere to the one-hour timeframe. The building will close with the conclusion of the last visit each day at 5:00 PM.
- **Parking and Entering the Building:** Please park in the East Wing parking lots. These include the parking spaces immediately in front of the East Wing entrance, extending up to the LGI or the lot on the side of the East Wing. An MHS staff member will be on site at the entrance to the East Wing to open the door and check you in.
- **Areas for Picture Taking:** Graduates and families will have access to the first floor of the East Wing, Cafeteria and Commons, Courtyard/Pond, East Gyms, Stadium (via unlocked Commons-area doors for exit to stadium and return to building) and Main Gym. The graduation stage and podium will be set up in the Main Gym. Graduates may take photographs on the stage. **Please note: All visitors to the stadium field are asked to avoid wearing high heels and other heeled shoes that may puncture and damage the turf field.**
- **Social Distancing and Safety Guidelines:** All visitors are required to wear masks when inside the school building. Masks may be momentarily removed for the purpose of picture taking. All graduates and families are asked to maintain a six-foot distance from other families visiting at the same time.

MHS administration will be available in the East Wing lobby and office to assist with any needs during your visit. Restrooms will be available throughout the open areas of the school building. We look forward to welcoming our graduates and families home to MHS!
